  - Applications for photo ID, the Voter Authority Certificate, must be received by no later than 5pm Wednesday 26 June 2024. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-to-vote.
  - Applications to appoint a proxy must be received by no later than 5pm on Wednesday 26 June
    2024. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote.
  - Applications to vote by emergency proxy on the grounds of physical incapacity, for work/service reasons or for the absence or loss of Voter ID after the deadline for proxy applications has passed, must be received by no later than 5pm on Thursday 4 July 2024.
