- 2. Approx. 240m section of Bridleway No. 351016 between grid references: 377735, 508032 and 377791, 507833.

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians, horses, or cyclists.

If the works have not been completed within the extension period, the order may be extended for a further period with the approval of the appropriate minister.
