The effect of the Order is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along an approx. 265 metre section of Public Footpath No. 358007 at Carleton Meadows in the Parish of Penrith from a point adjacent to No.7 Cold Springs Park, extending in an overall easterly direction to Grid Reference: 352594 530579.

A suitable alternative route for pedestrians is available along the footways of Milner Mount and Carleton Meadows.

If the works have not been completed within the extension period, the order may be extended for a further period with the approval of the appropriate minister.
