NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE APPORTIONMENT OF A RIGHT OF COMMON

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Janice Elizabeth Pickering** ("the Applicant") to Westmorland and Furness Council, as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 8 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014. The application relates to entry number 13 of common land register unit CL41 Roundthwaite Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows:

The right to graze 150 ewes, 30 hoggs and 2 fell ponies over the whole of the land comprised in the register unit, is recorded as attached to land at Townfoot Farm, Roundthwaite, Tebay, Westmorland comprising O.S. plots numbered 320, 361, 372, 373, 377, 395, 403, 405, 408 and 427 on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915) of the parish of Tebay, Westmorland ("the Right").

Pursuant to the division of the land to which the Right is attached, the Applicant seeks by this application to register apportionment of the Right appropriate to the part of land transferred and now in their ownership.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by making the following amendment to the commons register:

- 1. Entry number 13 will be deleted and reference made to the new corresponding entries.
- 2. Addition of supplemental maps.
- 3. The following entries will be made to the rights section of the commons register to show the proportionate apportionment of the Right to (a) the Applicant and (b) the remainder of the Right:
 - a. The right to graze 22.35 ewes, 4.47 hoggs and 0.30 fell ponies over the whole of the land comprised in the register unit, is recorded as attached to O.S. plots numbered pt361, 372, and pt408 on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915) of the parish of Tebay, Westmorland, as shown coloured red on the proposed supplemental map.
 - b. The right to graze 127.65 ewes, 25.53 hoggs and 1.7 fell ponies over the whole of the land comprised in the register unit, is recorded as attached to O.S. plots numbered 320, pt361, 373, 377, 395, 403, 405, pt408 and 427 on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915) of the parish of Tebay, Westmorland, as shown coloured green on the proposed supplemental map.

Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.
