A Proposal by Westmorland and Furness Council Section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 Correction of the Register The particulars of the right of common are incorrect

In accordance with regulation 18(1) of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 please find below a statement in writing describing the proposal and the justification behind it.

Description of the proposal:

It has become apparent that an error was made by the Commons Registration Authority in 2023 when creating entry 81 of the Rights section of commons register unit CL4 Crosby Garrett Regulated Common. The particulars of the right of common have been copied incorrectly from entry 71. The particulars of the right in column 4 of entry 71 of CL4 reflects the entry correctly. However, the particulars of the right at entry 81 of CL4 describe the right as also including the right of turbary and the right to take stone over the whole of the land comprised in the register unit. It is proposed to amend the description of the right in column 4 of CL4 to show the right to graze 68 sheep without lamb or lambs over the whole of the land comprised in the register unit or such other commonable animals equivalent to 68 stints, only.

Justification for the proposal:

The Commons Registration Authority believe that correcting this mistake, and therefore ensuring the accuracy of the commons register would be in the public interest, particularly as the above mentioned entry is to be transferred.

Notice is hereby given that a proposal has been made by **Westmorland and Furness Council** ("the Proposer") as the Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The proposal relates to register units CL4 Crosby Garrett Regulated common, Entry 81.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: On 27 March 2023 Carole Cockburn submitted an application to amend a right of common at Entry 71 to graze 68 sheep without lamb or lambs over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit or such other commonable animals equivalent to 68 stints ("the Right"). On 11 May 2023 the Commons Registration Authority incorrectly registered the Right to graze (a) 68 sheep or (b) such commonable animals equivalent to 68 stints together with the right of turbary and the right to take stone over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit at entry 81 of register unit CL4.

The Proposer seeks by this proposal to correct that mistake.

If the proposal is granted the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by:

a) deleting entry 81 of CL4 (making reference to the new corresponding entry) and making a new entry in the register to show the Right to graze 68 sheep without lamb or lambs over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit or such other commonable animals equivalent to 68 stints.
