

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL Duty to Consult on Felling Street Trees

Notice is hereby given that Westmorland and Furness Council proposes to remove three street trees.

From the date of this notice, there is a 28-day period in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the duty to consult requirements set out in **section 96A of the Highways Act 1980**.

Notice Date: 11th December 2024

Locations: Two trees located on Abbey Road, Stafford Street Crossing.

What3Words: ///chats.stole.gravel

The third tree located on Abbey Road opposite the Ainslie Street junction.

What3Words: ///reap.unity.perky

Species: Acer

Reasons for removal: As part of our active travel cycling and walking improvement scheme, we plan to remove these street trees to allow for the construction of the new cycleway and provide clear visibility to the proposed traffic signal heads on the new crossings.

Solution to consider: The trees that are removed will be replaced with new trees after construction of the scheme has finished.
