

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Election of Councillors

Notice is hereby given that

1. An election is to be held for a Town Councillor for the PENRITH EAST ward of Penrith Town Council.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered by hand to Voreda House, Portland Place, Penrith, CA11 7BF between 10am and 4pm on any working day from the date of publication of this notice (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on Friday, 28 February 2025.
3. Nomination papers may be obtained from the offices of the Returning Officer during the times stated above.
4. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 27 March 2025.
5. **Electors** should take note that the following applications must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address stated below by the deadline if they are to be effective for this election:
 - Applications to register to vote must be received by midnight on **Tuesday, 11 March 2025**. **Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.**
 - New applications to vote by post or amendments or cancellation of existing postal or proxy arrangements must be received by no later than **5pm Wednesday, 12 March 2025**. **Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote.**
 - Applications for photo ID, the Voter Authority Certificate, must be received by no later than **5pm Wednesday, 19 March 2025**. **Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-to-vote.**
 - Applications to appoint a proxy must be received by no later than **5pm on Wednesday, 19 March 2025**. **Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote.**
 - Applications to vote by emergency proxy on the grounds of physical incapacity, for work/service reasons or for the absence or loss of Voter ID after the deadline for proxy applications has past, must be received by no later than **5pm on Thursday, 27 March 2025**.
