

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (St GEORGES SCHOOL,
BARROW-IN-FURNESS) (PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONE)
EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2025

Westmorland and Furness Council ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 9 and 10, and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 22nd day of April 2025 for a period of up to eighteen months and may be cited as Westmorland and Furness Council (St Georges School, Barrow-in-Furness) (Pedestrian and Cycle Zone) Experimental Order 2025. The length of road specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby designated as a Pedestrian and Cycle Zone ("the Zone")

3. Save as is provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed along the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, during the days and times specified therein.

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to vehicles being used: -

- (a) for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance Purposes;
- (b) in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road, of any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) the removal of obstructions to traffic;
 - (ii) for, or in connection with, mechanical road cleansing or mechanical refuse collection;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of roads;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, that length of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.
- (c) in the service of a Local Authority or a water or sewerage undertaker which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) in the service of or employed by the Post Office to be used for the purpose of delivery or collection of postal packets as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000 to or from premises located within the Zone;

- (e) in use as a School Bus or for school transport purposes and being contracted to carry persons to or from a school located within the Zone;
- (f) for the conveyance of persons, goods or burden to or from premises situated within or accessible only from the Zone;
- (g) by any vehicle displaying a disabled badge, being driven by or carrying a disabled person to uplift or set down pupils attending Schools within the Zone
- (h) if it is employed by a local bus service operator and the vehicle is in use during a scheduled service as a Bus as defined in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016
- (i) in connection with any funeral undertaking from any premises located within the Zone.

Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any previous Order relating to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.

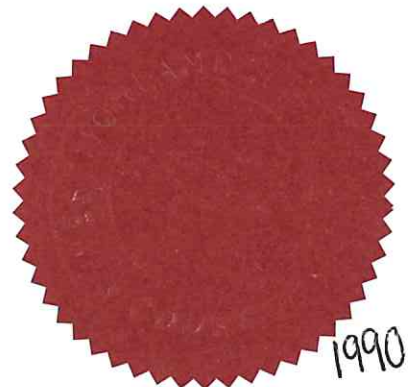

Pedestrian and Cycle Zone – Between 8.20 am and 9.00 am and between 3:10 pm and 3.50 pm each day, Monday to Friday inclusive, during Term Time Only

Street Name	Town	Restricted Length
Lumley Street	Barrow-in-Furness	From its junction with School Street, extending in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Rawlinson Street, a total distance of 96m.
